JUDICIAL SERVICE COMMISSION
VACANCY FOR STIPENDIARY MAGISTRATE
(& HM CORONER)

The Judicial Service Commission invites applications for the role of Stipendiary Magistrate and HM Coroner from persons who by virtue of their citizenship are entitled to take up employment and who are, or on employment will be, resident in Gibraltar.

Applicants must be barristers of Gibraltar or England and Wales, or Northern Ireland or the Republic of Ireland or Scottish advocates, or solicitors currently admitted to practice in Gibraltar or in a jurisdiction of the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland. They should have not less than eight years' experience since call or admission.

It is anticipated that the post holder will divide his/her time on a 80/20 basis between his/her role as Stipendiary Magistrate and HM Coroner. That proportion may vary depending upon volume of work and the exigencies of either role.

The appointment will be for a fixed term of three years in the first instance. The salary will be £109,562 per annum. This appointment is also pensionable on the Gibraltar Provident Fund No. 2 or the Government Guaranteed Superannuation Fund Pension Schemes.
