Revised court fees

The Chief Justice has reviewed and revised court fees, as reflected in the amending Rules listed below. The Registrar of the Supreme Court has also revised those fees falling within his remit. The revised fees will come into effect on 1 August 2025.

- Supreme Court (Amendment) Rules 2025
- Magistrates' Court (Amendment) Rules 2025
- Coroner (Amendment) Rules 2025
- Commissioners for Oaths and Public Notaries (Applications and Fees) (Amendment) Rules 2025
- Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) (Amendment) Rules 2025

Whilst the adjustments take account of the increase in the Retail Price Index, from the date each fee was originally introduced or last amended, careful consideration has also been given to ensuring that access to justice is maintained.

As from 1 August 2025, hearing fees (except hearings in care proceedings and fact-finding hearings relating to the welfare of children) will be payable in respect of any hearing listed for three days or more. The applicable fee must be paid within 14 days of the listing of the matter. These fees are non-refundable, including where the matter subsequently settles or does not proceed on the listed days. Failure to pay within the stipulated 14-day period will result in the matter being removed from the court's diary.


